

GIANT KILLERS

APOSTLE MARK KAUFFMAN

Now the Philistines gathered together their armies to battle, and were gathered together at Shochoh, which belongeth to Judah, and pitched between Shochoh and Azekah, in Ephesdammim. (2) And Saul and the men of Israel were gathered together, and pitched by the valley of Elah, and set the battle in array against the Philistines. (3) And the Philistines stood on a mountain on the one side, and Israel stood on a mountain on the other side: and there was a valley between them.

1Samuel 17:1-3

The battle of the end times is to take on giants. We are not looking for the Lord to rescue us out of the planet but for Him to use us to change it. Much like Goliath the enemy desires for you and I to stay on our mountain. The powers of darkness do not mind if we stay and rule the church mountain as long as we do not invade the other six mountains of society. The other six mountains are government, education, media, economy, family and entertainment. Once again, the end time battle is about taking these mountains and infiltrating them with the Kingdom of God.

While most of the church world, like Saul and his army, are waiting for God

to rescue and deliver them; the Lord is waiting for the Davids to arise, rescue and deliver creation. There is presently a battle between the Kingdom of God and the Kingdom of Darkness. All conflicts in the world at this present time are a result of the spiritual conflict between the Kingdom of God and the kingdom of darkness. While Saul's men are on the defense there is a Davidic company that is about to give hell a very bad day. Saul was no match for Goliath. A non-praising church is no match for the giants of this day. In Saul's twenty-five year reign, we cannot find Saul ever praising and worshipping the Lord. The church, in its present condition, has been in the state of paralysis and has been unable to overcome the giants of our day, but out of the place of obscurity is about to emerge Giant Killers who do not resemble Saul or his army. There is not a religious bone in their body. They are like David, men and women after God's heart; they are praisers and worshippers after the order of David. They are about to paralyze all of their enemies.

"Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings hast thou ordained strength because of thine enemies, that thou mightest still the enemy and the avenger." Psalms 8:2

The present day David's are arising with a fresh praise mantle that will dismantle their enemies. The Lord has

given us praise to confront all our enemies. Listen to David's praise language as he stood before Goliath. *'The battle is the Lord's he has given you into my hands today.'* We have to learn to speak to our giants putting the word on every enemy and circumstance we face. Maybe you presently are facing a giant that is looming over you or overshadowing you and out numbering you. The odds may not look very good, but you know the greater one who dwells within you is greater than any giant in your world. You've got to know there is no disease He can't heal, there is no problem He can't solve, no enemy He can't defeat, no stronghold He can't tear down, no mountain He can't move, no prison He can't open. If you know Him well enough and need Him bad enough He will show up on time.

David said 'in Judah is God known'. Judah means praise. Praisers know the Lord like no one else. We know God reveals Himself through His Word, but He also reveals Himself in praise. Saul knew God's law and prophetic word from Samuel's mouth, but did not know the Lord because he was not a praiser. When you need God, I know where you can find Him every time; in Judah, which is praise. I know where He resides. I have found His address in Judah. Oh yes, He inhabits the praises of His people. That is where He lives, that is where He dwells. As you praise Him, you will find Him as a storm stopping, water walking, death defying,

mountain moving, heroic healing, and miracle-making God. Our God is huge!

David said, *'O magnify the Lord come let us exalt his name together'*. David knew he could not make God bigger than he already is, but his praise magnified Him to make Him bigger in his own eyes. As we praise Him, we receive a revelation of how big our God is.

Back to our text, for forty days and forty nights Israel was in fear as they faced Goliath and the Philistine army, but the scenery was about to change. Out of the wilderness, out of obscurity, out of nowhere comes a nobody who God was about to make a somebody. The curtain was now drawn back to this praiser. God was about to promote. David was not looking for promotion. His passion was not to be king, a great leader, a great musician or captain of Saul's army. His passion was to manifest the presence of God through his praise and worship.

Advancing the kingdom and overcoming giants is a matter of violence. Every giant's purpose is to prohibit accessing God's purpose and plan for your life. All Goliath used was his voice. Words and thoughts come to intimidate and paralyze you from moving in God and fulfilling your kingdom assignment. You must dominate and dominator with your voice. By opening your mouth and giving the Holy Ghost a voice you bring down giants of sickness, disease, poverty, fear, worry, discouragement,

etc. Sing, worship, praise, decree, proclaim, shout, pray and prophesy the answer.

There is a company of Davids in the earth right now that must awake. They will use the technology of the Spirit and no longer be intimidated by the speech of our enemies. It is not how big we are in numbers. It is how big of a sound are we making. This powerful technology of praise and worship that David used infused him with 'dunamis' power enabling him to kill a lion, a bear and a giant. David is a prophetic prototype of a new breed of worshipping warriors. David's victory

had nothing to do with a rag and a rock, but the praise technology that he learned in the wilderness empowered him to overcome Goliath. When David showed up Goliath saw his last day. Goliath challenged the wrong man. Do not mess with praisers; he picked on the wrong man. When hell picks on you, they have picked on the wrong person. Whatever giants stand in your way they will fall before your praise.

Arise men and women of valor. Put on your garments of praise and get ready to subdue all your enemies.
